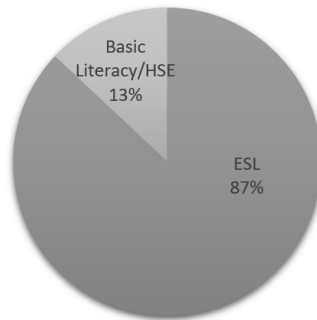
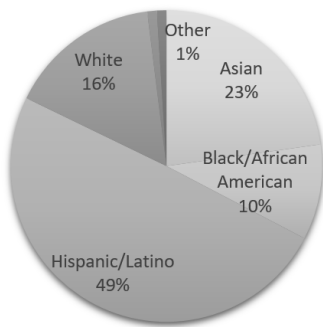




# Literacy New Jersey & Affiliates 2018-2019 Statistical Report

This past year, **5,493** adult literacy students in the Literacy NJ network received **179,883** hours of free instruction. Together, they met over **12,500** goals.
